Words with *ee, th, ir, ou, or, i-e*

Digraphs are two letters that make one sound. We call these special friends.

**ee** (What can you see?)

**th** (Down the tower, across the tower, then down the horse's head to the hooves and over his back)

**ir** (Whirl and twirl)

**ou** (Shout it out)

**or** (Shout the door)

A **split digraph** also contains two letters (i-e) but they are split between a consonant, for example; nice, bike, drive.

**i-e** (Nice smile)

Green words are words we can sound out using our phonics.
